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The St. Daniel's Education Opportunity Fund was established to help members defray the cost of early career training. Four grants of at least \$750.00 each will be awarded for the 2009-2010 academic year.

REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

- ① Eligibility shall be limited to confirmed members of St. Daniel's Lutheran Church who are in good standing. Good standing shall be (a.) persons who are active members of St. Daniel's Lutheran Church as defined by the constitution of St. Daniel's Lutheran Church; (b.) and persons who are engaged in church activities and/or committees, and/or persons who are attending regular church services.
- ② Applicants must be 25 years old or under.
- ③ The grant shall be a one time only award. A recipient of the grant shall not be eligible to apply in subsequent years. Non-recipients may reapply in subsequent years.
- ④ The applicant must be attending or must be enrolled in a formal course of study in a graduate or undergraduate college or university, or a post high school vocational, or a post high school technical school. Persons enrolled in professional or trade schools are also eligible.
- ⑤ No tests or other assessment materials are required other than items #1 and #2 above and item #10 below.
- ⑥ Applications must be returned to the church office and postmarked no later than June 30th.
- ⑦ Application forms are available in the church office.
- ⑧ Recipient shall be selected by random drawing.
- ⑨ The grant shall be paid jointly to the recipient and the school or training facility.
- ⑩ Applicants may be rejected by the committee if the training facility of the applicants choice is deemed not to be a reputable organization or program. Candidates shall be responsible for submitting descriptive material pertaining to their training program. Training programs contrary to the moral principles of the Lutheran Church shall also be ineligible.
